The Healing Ministry of Jesus

The Bible teaches that humans are composed of a Spirit, Soul, and Body (1 Thessalonians 5:23).

When we become Christians, our Spirit is transformed instantly, and the Holy Spirit dwells within us, making our Spirit perfect before God (2 Cor 5:17, Heb 4:16). However, the transformation of our soul (mind, will, emotions, personality, memory) and body is usually gradual, known as ongoing sanctification.

With the Holy Spirit, we grow in love, knowledge of Jesus, and spiritual fruits (Gal 5:22-23). We can also pray for the empowering of the Holy Spirit and spiritual gifts for service (1 Cor 12:8-10), similar to the events of Pentecost. Engaging in prayer and Bible study strengthens our faith.

As Christians, we move from the Kingdom of Darkness to the Kingdom of Christ (Col 1:13) and become aware of the spiritual battle around us. Though Jesus defeated Satan, he still influences the unsaved and parts of our unsanctified soul and body (1 John 5:19, Romans 6:16). Persistent negative behaviors might stem from deep-seated issues in our soul or body, requiring help to overcome. These could be linked to past hurts, unconfessed sins, or family history.

Dunamis' ministry model helps individuals, through the power of the Holy Spirit, to address these issues. Prayer ministers assist in uncovering, understanding, and breaking free from harmful patterns by helping individuals forgive, repent, and renounce embedded lies. Deepseated issues may sometimes involve demonic influences, which can be resolved through healing and, if necessary, commanding the influence to leave in Jesus' name. Multiple sessions may be needed for complex cases.
